

## Higher Education Emergency Financial Aid Grant (HEERR) Report Under the CRRSAA Emergency Relief Fund

In response to the crisis we are experiencing, the President of the United States granted an allocation to educational institutions. Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA), Pub. L.116-260 (December 27, 2020), this Act contains a new aid package for students enrolled at the Institution.

The institution appreciates that Congress and the President have made these funds available to eligible students. We take the receipt of these federal funds seriously and will be distributing them for the benefit of the institutional population. This first Fund report applies to the student portion received in the first payment.

The institution is making the following information available for transparency purposes and in accordance with the United States Department of Education's Electronic Announcement. - 1. The institution committed and developed to the Department the Certification and Agreement (for) CRRSAA Student Emergency Financial Aid Grants. The institution has used or intends to distribute the funds in four payments beginning with the first in April 2021, these funds are intended for Title IV recipient students.
- 2. The total amount of funds that the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the Certification and Agreement for the Grant of Emergency Financial Aid to students of the institution is \$498,597.00.
- 3. CRRSAA (HEERF II) funds were allocated by the Financial Aid Office to all eligible students who completed the form.
- 4. The total amount of emergency financial aid scholarships distributed to students as established in section 314(a)(4) of the CRRSAA as of the date of this first report as of April 27 was \$124,646.00
- 5. The total number of students who have received the emergency financial aid scholarship is 219 students with the amount of \$569.16.

6. The methods used by the institution to determine which students receive emergency financial aid awards and how much they would receive under section 18004(a)(1) of the CRRSAA are as follows:

## I. Eligibility

- a. This Policy applies to all students enrolled and active since April 15, 2021, and those who enroll after this date, until the fund is depleted.
- b. All students who have assets and are eligible for Title IV Funds will be eligible.

## II. Procedure

- a) Of the total funds assigned to Antilles College of Health, twenty-five (25%) percent will be assigned, among the students who comply with the provisions of section I (Eligibility) in the first payment:
- · Active continuing and newly admitted students will be eligible for this aid,
- Four payments will be made: April, July, October 2021, and January 2022.

Students are informed through various communications to institutional emails, where they are provided with instructions and guidance regarding CRRSAA scholarships and/or funds.
